Requestingan Accommodation for Specia Dietary Needs Procedure and Process

The Newburgh Enlarged City School District adheres to specific United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) iguidelines providing special dietary accommodations for students. A "reasonablemodification" is a changeor alteration in practices or procedures to accommodate a disability that ensures that all students have equal opportunity to participate in or bemediate for program. In accordance ith the criteria set forth in <u>CFR Part 15</u> those students who are inable to eat the school meal as is due to a disability or limitations caused by the sability. The USDA regulations for school nutrition programs does not request modifications for children whose pecial dietary needs do not constitute disability, including those related to religious or moral convictions, general health concerns, and personal food preferences.
